Olympic Shotgun Clinic

The Midway USA Foundation, Inc will host its first annual Olympic Shotgun Clinic August 14 & 15, 2010 at Prairie Grove Shooting Sports complex just outside Columbia, Missouri. The clinic will be conducted by two of the US Olympic Shotgun coaches: Bret Erickson the national shotgun coach and four time Olympian and Todd Graves a four time Olympian and bronze medalist in skeet. Each coach will have three assistant coaches who are current members of the US Olympic National Team and who will just have returned from the World Championship in Munich, Germany. This training is intended for any junior high, high school or college age shotgun shooter as well as their coaches who want to be exposed to Olympic level coaching. Remington will be the event sponsor and will be supplying all ammunition for the clinics.

During the two days of the clinic, both the sporting clays ranges and 5 -stand will be open for practice and just to have fun. Ammunition in 12 and 20 gauge will be available for sale at the club for these extra events.

There will be a cook-out Saturday evening at Prairie Grove Shooting Sports that is open to anyone to give an extra opportunity to talk with these talented coaches and National Team members. Tickets for this event can be purchased with your registration or will be on sale throughout the day Saturday.

The clinics will be on Saturday with each clinic lasting three hours and each registrant shooting 100-150 rounds depending on how instruction goes. Space is limited so dates and times are on a first come first serve basis. Please get your registration in as soon as possible but not later than July 15, 2010. Sunday will be open shooting with Olympic team members available to shoot a round of trap, skeet, 5-stand or clays with anyone interested. Bring a two person team and challenge a two person Olympic team to a two person flurry.
